BOYS FOOTBALL

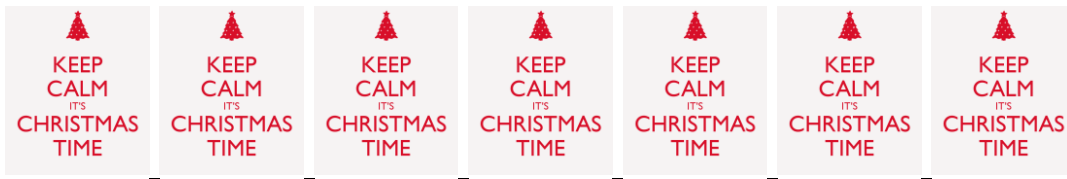
The boys won a recent 5-a-side football tournament held at St Anne's Academy.
