FOOTWEAR

In September, please ensure that your child comes to school in footwear that conforms to the school uniform policy, which states black shoes. Trainers, boots and canvas type shoes are not part of school footwear.

Children who participate in lunchtime sports activities are encouraged to bring a change of footwear for lunchtimes if they wish.

ACCESSORIES

Small, simple stud earrings may be worn but these need to be removed for P.E. Chains, bracelets and nail varnish are not part of school uniform. Pupils with shoulder length, or longer, hair must have it tied back neatly and out of their eyes. Hair bobbles should be black or brown or in keeping with school colours (blue/yellow). Large coloured bows are not permitted.

P.E KIT & FOOTWEAR

Our P.E. kit is plain white t-shirt, black shorts/track pants and trainers. Pumps are used only for gymnastics. For outdoor P.E, children may wear their Hollin jumpers/cardigans or bring one from home. Again, please ensure all P.E kit has your child's name in it.
