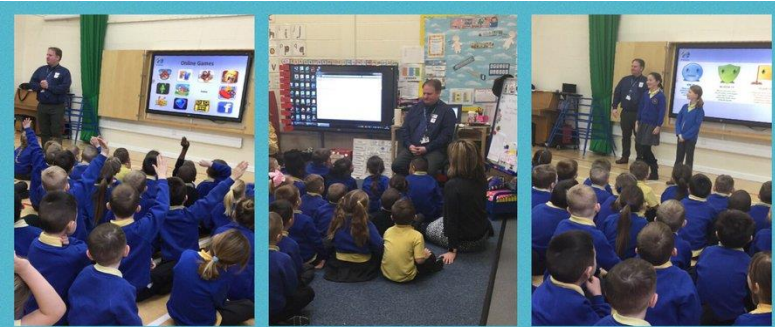


E-Safety day – 5th February 2018
