**Facebook** allows you to create a page all about yourself. There is the opportunity for sharing photos and videos and talking to

**Twitter** lets you post public or private 'Tweets', send and receive private messages and post videos/pictures.

**Snapchat** allows you to send messages or photos to other users. The pictures can only be viewed for a set amount of time.

**WhatsApp** is an instant messenger app that allows you to send messages to other users. Photos, videos and locations can also be shared.



**YouTube** allows you to watch, create and comment on videos on a public profile.



**Instagram** is a photo and video sharing app. You can send and receive messages.



**Skype** allows you to send messages and make audio and video calls to others around the world.



**Pinterest** is an interactive 'pins board' for a collection of your own and others' images.



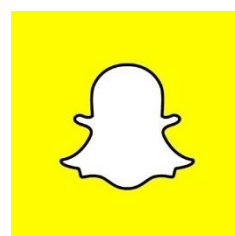
**Minecraft** is a game that allows you to create a virtual world using building blocks. It also allows you to chat to others.



**Roblox** is a game where you can create your own games, play others' games and chat with other users.

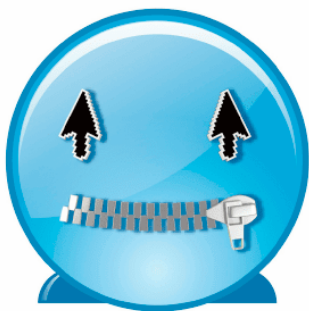

We ask our pupils to remember vital information if they come across something that could pose a risk...



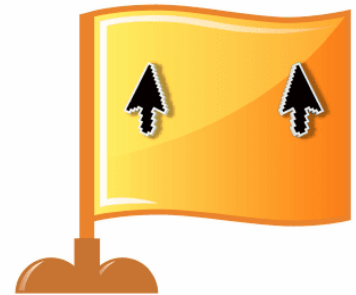
